 1. Completed application (pages 2-4 of this document)
 2. Current official high school transcript, including class rank
 3. Letter of acceptance from a post-secondary school
- All decisions made by the selection committee are final.
- The selection committee consists of WSCA members associated with previous year scholarship winners.
- Scholarship winners will be contacted in early May.
